**Location - JK1. Entrance via Darwell Close**

- None seen at the time of the visit.

**Location – JK2. (Previously a fire occurred here).**

- Leaf wiped approximately ten stems.



**Location - JK 3. (Area backing onto residential gardens)**

- Four small plants were identified and herbicide treated.



**Location - JK4. (Beside a pathway at the top end of the site)**

- No Japanese knotweed seen here at the time of the visit.



**Location - JK5. (In front the netball courts).**

- Small stunted Japanese knotweed plants seen, where appropriate they were treated. In the location where a few trees had previously been removed three stems of Japanese knotweed were seen and treated.





**Location - JK6. (Next to JK5.)**

- At the time of the visit no Japanese knotweed was seen here.



**Location - JK7 and JK8. Beside the main road.**

- Three Japanese knotweed shoots seen and herbicide treated. (They were in amongst the brambles and unable to take clear photo of them.)
